1. Manual Handling - Lifting of Heavy Equipment	Staff	- Low	- OH&S Manual Handling Training. - Trolley - Two person lift
2. Environmental conditions - Weather - Surfaces - Equipment	Staff Students	- Low	- Assess weather conditions before and during activity (eg temperature, storms). - Check all equipment is in good condition (i.e nets, lines, balls)
3. Exposure to UV Radiation and heat - Sunburn - Heat stroke - Heat Stress	Staff Students	- High	- Water, SPF 30+ Sunscreen, and shade tent available for all staff and students. - Suitable staff uniforms & sunglasses - Recommendations for students to wear appropriate 'sun smart' attire and bring a water bottle. - Take regular drink breaks.
4. Injury through foreign objects in the sand	Staff Students	- Low/Medium	- Staff to check condition of sand prior to commencement of class. - Council's regularly clean the beach with appropriate equipment. - Staff with First Aid Qualification on site - First Aid kit on site
5. Physical exertion - Strains and sprains - Cramps - Exhaustion and Fatigue	Staff Students	- Low	- Staff with First Aid qualifications on site. - Basic First Aid kit on site. - Appropriate warm up and cool down exercises to help prevent injuries. - Work cover policy for staff. Report all injuries and near misses. - Public liability insurance of \$10,000,000 and professional indemnity insurance of \$2,000,000. - Continuously monitor students for signs of fatigue and exhaustion
6. Students - Student numbers - Special needs - Medical conditions - High risk behaviour	Staff Students	- Low	- Ensure there is adequate supervision. - Introduce rules, safety procedures and prerequisite skills. - When necessary, obtain advice from students teachers. - Recommend all students with medical conditions bring their own medications (i.e Ventolin, EpiPen etc) and leave with supervising teacher.
7. Staff - Adequately trained	Staff Students	- Low	- First Aid Qualified - Working with Children Check - Level 1 Coaching qualifications or Competence in the teaching of beach volleyball.
